

Participants engage with a live drama unfolding on stage, using sound, language, lighting, scenography, and narrative to inspire their artistic responses.

As audience members, they are invited to sketch their impressions of the performance, creating a unique interplay between receptivity and creativity.

This experience not only fosters artistic expression but also serves as a powerful therapeutic tool, promoting healing and self-discovery through art.
