WHAT IS RETROFIT DOUBLE GLAZING?


Retrofit double glazing is the process of replacing your existing single glazing with new double glazed units using your existing joinery. The process is quick and unobtrusive. The main difference you will notice is a more comfortable temperature.

The diagram below shows old single glazing with heat escaping from your home, and with RetroFit Low E double glazing the heat gets reflected back into your home.

EXAMPLE OF A RETROFIT DOUBLE GLAZING UPGRADE




*Retrofit double glazing can be installed to existing aluminium or timber frames.



WHAT IS Low E?

Low E is short for Low Emissivity which means the glass has a unique invisible coating designed to let light in and reflect heat back into your home, reducing heat loss. With the right product using a custom solar control Low E option, you can reduce solar heat gain. This gives you the ultimate thermal performance upgrade from your standard double glazing.





The point of comparison is classic single glazing for all the infographics data points above. The figures above are based on units with a 12mm spacer and 4mm glass units on both sides.

At lower internal temperatures and high humidity, there's a greater chance of condensation forming on the inside of a home's windows. This can cause mould, mildew, and in some cases rot timber window frames. With a warmer home the chance of condensation forming on the windows reduces.

KEEPING YOUR HOME COOL AND REDUCE FADING

SAFETY AND SECURITY
