# Q: Do I have to stop using the shower? When can I start using it again after the work has been completed?

A: If the shower is leaking and causing damage then yes, it is preferable to stop using the shower. However, in most cases it is usually quite a gradual leak so therefore the difference will be minimal between the time we quote to the time the work is completed so it is certainly not a necessity, especially if there is only one shower in the house. Once the shower has been re-grouted it will be 24 hours before it can be reused.

# Q : Should the shower screen be replaced before or after the re-grouting?

A: If you are considering having the shower screen replaced, it is recommended this is done before any grouting work.

Ask one of the Grout Gals at Grout HQ or your local Grout Guy who we recommend.

### Q: How long does the work take?

A: For a standard shower re-grout, allow between 3-4 hours, but it can vary depending on how difficult the grout is to remove, the size of the tiles, the width of grout joints, etc.

#### Q: Do you use mould resistant silicone and grout?

A: Yes, we do have antifungal agents in both our grout and silicone.

# Q : Do you clean tiles and grout?

A : No, unfortunately The Grout Guy does not provide cleaning services, we specialize in grout replacement. Ask one of the Grout Gals at Grout HQ or you your local Grout Guy who we recommend.




