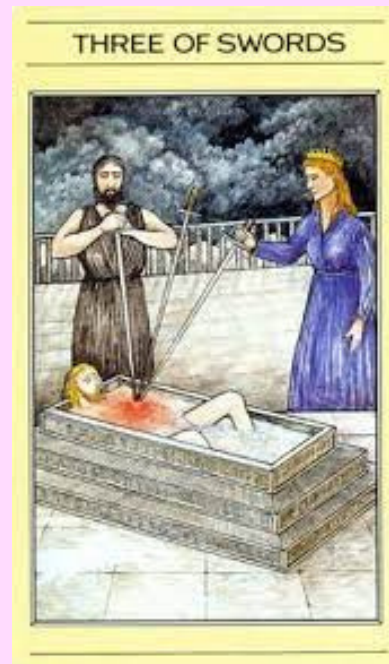
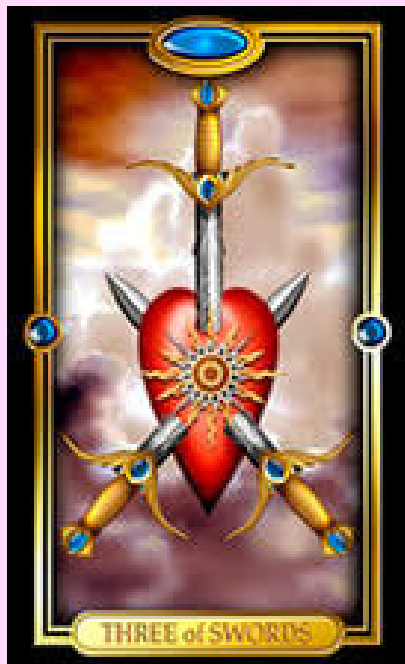




COMPARISON OF EQUIVALENTS

What are the main differences between them? In what scenario does the event take place? What emotions do these cards convey? What do they have in common?

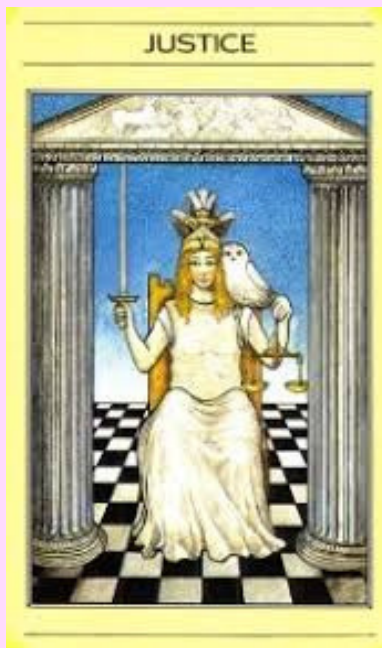
