Work Placement: This course includes a minimum of 200 hours of work placement.



CHC50121 Diploma of Early Childhood Education and Care

This qualification is for those wanting to take on higher levels of responsibility and leadership in an early childhood setting. You will learn how to design and implement the curriculum in children's learning and development, and acquire the skills you need to foster the holistic development and wellbeing of children.

Work Placement: This course includes a minimum of 300 hours of work placement.

Career Prospects: Child Care Educator, Family Day Care Scheme Director/Manager, ECEC Team Leader



You will be able to apply advanced practical knowledge to coordinate, facilitate and maintain the Work Health and Safety (WHS) program in one or more fields of work in an organisation, such as a WHS practitioner or HR practitioner.

Career Prospects: Health and Safety Manager, Health and Safety Practitioner, Senior Work Health and Safety Officer. Individuals who are looking to apply specialised knowledge in a variety of contexts, will benefit from this course.

Delivery Options: Face-to-Face | Flexi Learn | PIT*





This qualification covers the competencies required to interpret and to convey information using specific terminology for a specific audience.

Career Prospects: Freelance interpreter, linguist or contract work with health, education, legal, business and travel agencies, teacher (ESL).

Additional Information: Students are required to pass an enrolment assessment conducted by AIWT trainers. This is a NAATI Endorsed Qualification. This NAATI endorsed qualification covers the competencies required to translate special purpose texts, to convey information written using specific terminology for a specific audience in functionally equivalent translated texts that are accurate and appropriate to the context, target audience and end use. Languages available: Chinese.

Career Prospects: Freelance translator, communications officer, localisation specialist, linguist or contract work with translating agencies.

Additional Information: Students are required to pass an enrolment assessment conducted by AIWT trainers. This is a NAATI Endorsed Qualification. Upon successful completion of the course, a graduand/graduate may apply to sit a Certification Test (NAATI Certified Translator Test) directly with NAATI.

Delivery Options: Face-to-Face

DELIVERY OPTIONS EXPLAINED

FACE-TO-FACE CLASSROOM

This delivery mode is predominantly delivered in a classroom over the nominated time with regular weekly classes and school holiday term breaks This allows for a live interaction between students and trainers.

TRAINEESHIPS

Traineeships are an excellent way to combine training with work, enabling you to have a job while you complete training towards a nationally recognised qualification. They are available to anyone of working age. You can do a traineeship even if you are still in school, re-entering the workforce or simply wishing to build on your career.

Traineeships can take between one to two years to complete and offer a broader range of vocational and occupational choices. A traineeship provides hands-on skills and work experience, and can improve your employment prospects and range of career choices. VOCATIONAL EDUCATION AND TRAINING (VET) IN SCHOOLS

Vocational Education and Training (VET) is a program delivered to Year 11 and 12 school students as part of your Western Australian Certificate of Education. We provide regular progress and attendance reports to parents and schools, ensuring students have the best chance of success.

FLEXI LEARN

This delivery mode is ideal for learners capable of managing a high amount of self-directed studies. AIWT offer a combination of self paced learning and face to face monthly workshops.

SCHOOL BASED TRAINEESHIPS

School-based traineeships provide school students who are generally at least 15 years of age with valuable employment skills, hands-on industry experience and a nationally recognised qualification, while still completing secondary school qualifications.

As a trainee, you will go to school and, with the school's approval, you and a guardian (if you are under 18) will sign a training contract with an employer in your chosen industry. You will have an employer who will employ and train you on the job and AlWT will provide you with formal off-the-job training throughout your traineeship. A school-based trainee will complete 7.5 hours per week of paid work with an employer.

PRIORITY INDUSTRY TRAINING (PIT)

Priority industry training programs and qualifications equip students to take up jobs in skilled occupations that are in high demand across Western Australia. Priority industry qualifications are updated each year to reflect changes in the WA economy. Delivery mode is classroom.

CPCWHS1001 PREPARE TO WORK SAFELY IN THE CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRY

You will be trained to demonstrate personal awareness and knowledge of health and safety legislative requirements in order to work safely and prevent injury or harm to self and others.

This unit is necessary for anyone intending to work in the construction industry in Australia.

Duration: Half day training



HLTAID012 PROVIDE FIRST AID IN AN EDUCATION AND CARE SETTING (INCLUDES HLTAID009*)

This course provides the skills and knowledge required to provide a first aid response to infants, children and adults and specifically applies to educators and support staff working within an education and care setting. This unit of competency satisfies the requirement set for approved first aid, asthma and anaphylaxis training for childcare staff and educators.

Duration: One day training**



HLTAID011 PROVIDE FIRST AID (INCLUDES HLTAID009*)

This course will provide you with the skills on how to provide life support and management of casualties in a range of situations until the arrival of medical assistance. You will also learn how to perform cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) if someone has stopped breathing.

Duration: One day training**



HLTAID009 PROVIDE CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION

You will gain the skills and knowledge required to perform cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) in line with the Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) Guidelines.

APPLY by filling in an online application on our website **www.aiwt.edu.au** or request one by emailing futurestudents@aiwt.edu.au




STEP 3

ELIGIBILITY FOR SUBSIDISED TRAINING

WA-funded places (DTWD Traineeships and PIT) are available only to permanent residents and holders of select visa subclasses. You are eligible for a guaranteed training place if you have left school and are:

- An Australian citizen; or a permanent visa holder; or
- Holders of a sub-class 309, 444, 785, 790, or 820 visa;
- Secondary holders of a temporary visa of sub-class 457; and
- Holders of a Bridging Visa E (subclasses 050 and 051) where the visa holder has made a valid application for a visa of subclass 785 or 790.
- Must be at least 15 years old; If you are under 18 years of age, you must have a Department of Education (DoE) Notice of Arrangement

ELIGIBILITY FOR CONCESSION

If you are in receipt of a current concession rate, you must present this to Student Services at time of enrolment. Eligibility for the concession rate on course fees is determined at the time of enrolment. The following students are entitled to the concession rate on course fees:

- Persons and dependants of persons holding:
 - o a Pensioner Concession Card;
 - o a Repatriation Health Benefits Card issued by the Department of Veterans' Affairs; or
 - o a Health Care Card.
- Persons and dependants of persons in receipt of services from the following Commonwealth support or employment services programs:
 - o Workforce Australia; or
 - o ParentsNext.
- Persons and dependants of persons in receipt of AUSTUDY or ABSTUDY.
- Persons and dependants of persons in receipt of the Youth Allowance.
- Persons and dependants of persons who are inmates of a custodial institution.
- Secondary school-aged persons, not enrolled at school.

In addition, the annual course fee cap for targeted fee relief courses are \$400 and includes people aged 15—24.
